



CERTIFICATE OF NO ACCIDENTS FOR PILOTS.

ICAO Annex 13, Regulation (EU) 996/2010 and SL499.22, protects the information gathered by the Safety Investigation Authorities (BAAI). As a result of the mentioned regulations and ICAO instructions, this information must be used exclusively by BAAI for the purpose of preventing future accidents and improve safety. The information provided to third parties is for safety purposes only and may not be used in any other way other than during a technical investigation.

For this reason, the final reports of the Safety Investigation Authorities do not include any personal details. The simple fact of checking the information gathered by the Safety Investigation Authority to verify if a pilot is included therein would imply inappropriate use.

In light of the foregoing applicable laws and regulations BAAI is required to use appropriately the information gathered during the investigation process and to keep it confidential. Requests for a *Certificate of No Accident for Pilots* and other similar information about individuals are not included in any of the provisions of the relevant laws and regulations above.
